Suggested Supply List

Basically, all you need to start is ONE good brush, good watercolor paint, and paper.

Watercolor Brushes – suggestions:

Beginners – Princeton Neptune #12 Round (synthetic)

1" wash optional

Intermediate – Silver Black Velvet #12 Round (blend)

Silver Black Velvet 1" wash

Watercolor Paint – Suggest tube paint

Beginners -Winsor Newton Cotman or Grumbacher Academy sets or
(Minimally get 3 tubes of paint, Red, Blue, and Yellow)

Intermediate – Daniel Smith, Winsor Newton, Holbein, DaVinci, tubes.

Watercolor Paper – 140lb cold pressed

Beginners – w/c paper pads – CansonXL

Strathmore 400 series

Fabriano Studio

Intermediate – Arches 22X30 full sheets, cut to ¼ shts, pads, or blocks

Bring: water containers, 2 lg plastic

Paper towels, Kleenex

Palette with lg mixing area

Paint board (available in class \$1)

Masking tape

Pencil & kneaded eraser

Other useful supplies:

Pebeo drawing gum

Rag towel or sponge

Saral graphite transfer
